



FRM Fire Warden Awareness Course

Course Overview:

The fire warden course is designed to, give knowledge and confidence to people who have a key role regarding the management of fire safety in the workplace. This course covers emergency and none emergency situations related to the role of the fire warden.

Benefits

This course provides the delegates with a theoretical and practical understanding of the duties of a fire warden within a workplace. This course will cover fire awareness giving delegates an understanding of how fires start and propagate within their workplace. Also delegates will understand fire safety measures and procedures to implement in emergency and non-emergency situations.

Course Content

- The role and responsibilities of the Fire Warden
- Understanding relevant Legislation
- The importance of good fire safety management
- The importance of regular fire drills
- How fire and smoke spreads within buildings
- Fire safety measures in the workplace
- Actions in the event of a fire
- Use of fire fighting equipment
- Common causes of fires in the workplace
- Assist in simulated and live emergency evacuation situations
- Human behaviour in a fire situation

Practical Use of Fire Extinguishers

Practical use of fire extinguishers can be incorporated into this course if required; a fire-training simulator will be used for the live fire training.

Training Team

All trainers conducting this course will have been employed as competent operational fire fighters by a local fire authority.

Entry Requirements

There are no prerequisites for this qualification other than participants must be physically able to safely perform the role of Fire Warden in their workplace.

Course Duration

This programme is held over 4 hours
